

Notice of location of Mineral Claim by Wm. Clegg
 To whom it may concern. Notice is hereby
 given that I the undersigned, Citizen of the United States,
 over the age of 21 years, having complied with all
 the requirements of Chapter 6. of Title 52. of the Revised
 Statutes of the United States and the local mining laws,
 said and customs have located a Quartz Claim on this
