FROM L. ESTES TO GEO. BROUGHTON.

Know all men by these presents, that I, Levi Estes of the City of Portland Multnomah County Oregon, in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred (\$1800) Dollars, to me paid by George Broughton of Oregon City, have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell and convey set on and assign unto the said George Broughton, an undivided one half of all the following described property situate and being in the County of Skamania Washington Territory, "To Wit". That certain Saw Mill situated on the North bank of the Columbia River heretofore owned and operated by William Grant and all the Machinery implements and fixtures thereto belonging and all the building and sheds connected therewith, including the Mill House Dwelling House Mess House, Blacksmith Shop and all other buildings used at and about said Mill and in connection therewith and the Blacksmith Forge, Furnace and tools also Furniture, Yoke of Oxen and the yokes and chains used in connection therewith at and about said Mill also two wagons, used at and about the said mill also the flumes, shoots and booms heretofore used in transporting and hauling timber, and lumber in connection with the operation of said mill, also all the furniture storer, fixtures, implements and all articles of personal property, heretofore belonging to the said William Grant and by him transferred to A. C. Phelps and Levi Estes, and used at or about in connection with said mill. To have and to hold the said property to the said Geo. Broughton, together with all the right, privileges appurtenances, and property heretofore held by said William Grant, and by him transferred to said A. C. Phelps, and Levi Estes to be held and owned by the said Geo. Broughton, and his heirs and assigns forever.
