

Notice of Location of Red Cliff Mine by Brown & Marshall
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby
 given that the undersigned citizen of the United
 States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having
 complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title
 Thirty-three of the revised Statutes of the United States
 and of all other mining laws therof, and of the State
 of Washington, and the local custom, laws, rules and reg-
 ulation of miners, did, on the 6th day of October, A.D.
 1896, locate and by this Notice do hereby locate a tract
 claim known as the Red Cliff Mine Lode or mining claim
 said claim having been discovered the 6th day of October
 1896 and its claim fifty thousand linear feet on this lode
 lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet
 in width the same being three hundred feet on each side
 of the center thereof, together with all dips, fissures, eagles
 and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex, of which are
 within said boundaries, twenty acres, situated in
 Cedar Creek District, County of Klamath, State of Washington,
 said location being described and distinctly marked by
 reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and most
 particularly described as follows to wit:

Commencing at the Discovery Post-Running 100 feet in
 a Southwesterly direction to South Easterly corner Post then 1500 feet
 to South Easterly corner Post then 200 feet to Easterly Center Post
 then 500 feet to North Easterly corner Post then 1500 feet to North
 Easterly corner Post then 200 feet to place of beginning.

And we intend to hold and work said claim in ac-
 cordance with the local customs and rules of miners and
 the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Wash-
