West Samson Lode East Discovery Claim
Notice of Location

In compliance with the U.S. Mining Laws and the regulations of St. Helens Mining District Klamath County State of Washington I located the East Discovery Claim of the West Samson Lode Locality Below a high cliff west of the Samson Excelsior Lode Discovery. Location notice on discovery itself and about 30 feet high burnt stump of a big fir tree Decomposed ore all around South Slope of Star Mountain northwest of Camp Samson about one mile.
