

Notice of location of the Maggie C. Quartz claim by Charles W. Brigham and C. Cole
to whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that we Charles W. Brigham and C. Cole
a citizen of the United States of America over the age of twenty one years, having
complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty two of the revised
statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws there of, and
of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations
of miners did on the 10th day of September A. D. 1896 locate and by this
notice do hereby locate a quartz claim known as the Maggie C. Cole or
mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 10 day of September
1896 and do claim (fifteen hundred feet ^{linear} on this lead, lead or vein
bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same
being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together
with all dips, spurs, and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or
apex of which lie within said boundaries.) (Twenty acres of mining ground),
situated in Copper Creek dist. County of Skamania State of Washington
said location being described and distinctly marked by reference
to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly
described as follows, to wit: This claim is on copper creek the center
is in the center of said copper creek and runs in a southerly
direction 1500 feet from center stake at north end to center stake
at south end thence 800 feet west to corner thence 1500 feet in
a northerly direction to the corner stake thence 800 feet east to
center stake in copper creek thence 800 feet in a easterly direction
to corner thence 1500 feet in a southerly direction to corner thence
800 feet west to center stake at south end the center at the north
end is up above river creek about one hundred yards from where
the creeks come together. And we intend to hold and work said
claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners
and the mining laws of the United States and of the state of
Washington.
