F. A. Young.

Notice is hereby given that David Vinyard of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of four foot cord wood, being about 80 cords in quantity, which was cut in Skamania County, State of Washington, and is now lying in Skamania County, State of Washington, about three miles in a Northwesterly direction from what is known as the Collins Hot Springs Hotel, for labor performed upon, and assistance rendered in and about cutting, hauling and loading said cordwood to market;

That the name of the owner or reputed owner is F. A. Young; that F. A. Young employed said David Vinyard to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions to-wit;

The said F. A. Young agreed to pay the said David Vinyard for such labor and assistance the sum of \$4.50 per day; That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said David Vinyard, who performed labor upon and assisted in and about cutting, hauling and preparing said cord wood for market for the period of seventy three days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said cordwood between the first day of December, 1912, and the 9th day of February, 1913, and thirty days have elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for such services is \$109.50; that no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and remains unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets the sum of \$109.50 in which amount he claims a lien upon said cord wood. The said David Vinyard also, claims a lien on all the said cord wood now owned by the said F. A. Young of said County to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining and securing the said cord wood herein described.
