

Notice of location of the Ward Murray Lode claim by Margaret M. Ward.
to whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that Margaret M. Ward citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty-two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the state of Washington and the local customs, laws rules & regulations of miners did on the 10th day of February A. D. 1897 locate and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim known as the Ward Murray Lode or mining claim said claim having been discovered the 28th day of January 1897 and do claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in ~~place~~ width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof together with all dips, spurs, and angles and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie in said boundaries situated in Leeper Creek mining district county of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to wit: Beginning at this stake and notice on Raymond Creek it runs fifteen hundred feet in a northerly direction to the center end stake thence 300 feet in an easterly direction to the northeast corner stake thence 1600 feet in a southerly direction to the southeast corner stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the center end stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the south west corner stake thence 1600 feet in a northerly direction to the north west corner stake thence 300 feet in an easterly direction to the center end stake. The discovery shaft is 100 feet north of this notice and center end stake and the notice and center end stake is 500 feet up the stream of Raymond Creek from where it empties into Canyon Creek. and I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs & rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of
