Blood) According to the Provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 Entitled an act making further Provision for the Sale of the Public Lands and the Acts Supplemental thereto for the East half of the North West quarter and the East half of the South West quarter of Section twelve in Township three north of Range Nine East of the Willamette Meridian in Washington Territory containing One hundred and Sixty Acres.

According to the Official Plat of the Survey of the Said Land s Returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been Purchased by the said Edwin A. Blood.

Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the Premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and Provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Edwin A. Blood) and to his ---heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the Rights Privileges Immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Edwin A. Blood and to his ----heirs and assigns forever subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining agricultural Manufacturing or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used

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
