

Notice of location of the Sam. Rafael quartz claim by J. K. Manning
 To whom it may concern

Notice is hereby given that J. K. Manning citizen of the United States / America over the age of twenty one years having complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners did on the 10th day of February A. D. 1897 locate and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim, known as the Sam. Rafael lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 28th day of January 1897 and do claim (fifty) or hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being 300 feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries (Twenty acres of placer mining ground) situated in Copper Creek mining district County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows to wit:

Beginning at this stake and notice it runs 1000 feet in a northerly direction to the center end stake thence 300 feet in an easterly direction to the north east corner stake thence 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the south east corner stake thence 300 in a westerly direction along the line of the Manning Johnston claim to the center end stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction along the line of the Manning Johnston claim to the south west corner stake thence 1000 feet in a northerly direction to the north west corner stake thence 300 feet in an easterly direction to the center end stake

The discovery is in the small stream 100 feet above the falls near the center of this claim

And I intend to hold and work said claims in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of
