Locality Bed of Dundercreek below a Cascade of about 15 feet north of a beaver marsh in Samson basin in the Upper Fork of the valley about 150 feet north of Camp Samson. West Samson Side West Discovery claim
Notice of location

In compliance with the U. S. Mining Laws and the regulations of St. Helens Mining District Klamath County Washington I located the West Samson discovery claim of the West Samson Side. Locality. Below a high cliff west of the Samson Excelsior Side Discovery location notice on discovery itself on about 30 feet high burnt stump of a fir tree Decomposed ore all around. On the slope of Star Mountain north west of Camp Samson about one mile. Boundaries from place of discovery 300 feet north thence 1500 feet west thence 600 feet south thence 1500 feet east thence 300 feet north to place of beginning Direction magnetic feet linear. Discovered and located June 17th 1895
