

Notice of location of the claim George Washington by J.K. Manning
To whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that J.K. Manning citizen of the United States of America over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws and of the state of Washington and the local customs laws, rules and regulations of miners did on the 12th day of February A.D. 1897, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim, known as the George Washington lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 12th day of February 1897, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being ~~thence~~ ^{thence} ~~thence~~ ^{thence} feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie ^{with} ~~in~~ said boundaries) (twenty acres of placer mining ground) situated in County of State of said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to wit: Beginning at the stake and notice on Copper creek it runs 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the center end stake thence 800 in a easterly direction to the south east corner stake thence 1000 feet in a northerly direction along the line of the Ellen Wood Claim to the north east corner stake on the north bank of Copper creek. thence down the north bank of Copper creek 300 feet to the center end stake thence down the stream of Copper creek 800 feet to the north west corner post thence 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the south west corner stake thence 300 feet in an easterly direction to the center end stake and I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington
