

Notice of location of the claim Thomas Jefferson by D. W. Ward.
To whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that D. W. Ward citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six of title thirty two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the state of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 12th day of A. D. 1897, locate and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim, known as the Thomas Jefferson lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 12th day of February 1897 and do claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries, situated in Copper Creek mining district County of Skamania State of Washington, said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to-wit: Beginning at this stake and notice on the north side of Copper Creek it runs 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the center end stake thence 300 feet in an easterly direction to the south east corner stake thence 1000 feet in a northerly direction along the line of the George Washington claim to the north east corner stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the center end stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the northwest corner stake thence 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the southwest corner stake thence 300 feet in an easterly direction to the center end stake and I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
