Certificate) Whereas Hiram A. Leavens of Multnomah County Oregon has deposited in  
NO. 564 ) the general land office of the United States a certificate of the Reg-  
ister of the land office at Vancouver whereby it appears that full payment has been  
made by the said Hiram A. Leavens according to the provisions of the act of Con-  
gress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled an act making further provision for the  
sale of the public lands for the lot numbered four of section thisty five in town-  
ship two North of Range Six East in the district of lands subject to sale at Van-  
couver Washington Territory containing forty two acres and rifty hundredths of an  
acre. According to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to  
~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ the general land office by the surveyor general which  
said tract has been purchased by the said Hiram A. Leavens now know ye that the  
United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the  
several acts of congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and  
by these presents do give and grant unto the said Hiram A. Leavens and to his heirs  
the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the  
Rights privileges, immunities and appurtenances of Whatsoever nature thereunto be-  
longing unto the said Hiram A. Leavens and to his heirs and assigns forever in test-  
imony whereof I, Andrew Johnson President of the United States of America have caused  
these letters to be made patent and the seal of the general land office to be here-  
unto affixed given under my hand at the city of Washington the Second day of July in
