THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

To all to whom these presents shall come greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in the general Land Office of the United States a Certificate Numbered Ninety Nine of the Register and Receiver at Vancouver Washington Territory whereby it appears that under the provisions of the act of Congress approved the 27th day of September 1850 Entitled an act to create the Office of Surveyor General of the Public lands in Oregon and to provide for the Survey and to make Donations to Settlers of the said public lands and the legislation supplemental thereto the claims of John D. Woodward of Skamania County, Washington Territory Notification No. 1473 has been established to a donation of One quarter section or One hundred and Sixty acres of land and that the same has been surveyed and designated according to the Official Plat of survey returned to the general land office by the surveyor General as the North East quarter of the North East quarter and Lots one, two and three in section thirty five and Lot three in Section thirty six all in township two North of Range six East in the District of lands subjects to Sale at
