

Notice of location of placer claim by W. H. Presleigh & Robt. Stoppen.

Feb. 23. 1897

To all whom it may concern that we W. H. Presleigh and Robert Stoppen citizens of the United States and over the age of twenty one years of age have complied with all the requirements of law and endowments have located the following described placer ground in the Sugar head district on the Coy creek Skamania Co Washington 20 acres beginning at a hemlock tree where this notice is posted and running west 20 rods thence South 80 rods thence east 40 rods thence North North 80 rods thence west 20 rods to place of beginning about 100 yards South of a cut canyon said canyon about 25 yards long and about 1 1/2 miles south of what is known as camp creek a tributary of the Coy creek the corners of this claim are distinctly marked and side and end lines Blazed
