

Notice of location of the Quartz claim Lawrence by J. K. Manning  
To whom it may concern

Notice is hereby given that J. K. Manning citizen of the United States of America over the age of twenty-one years having complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty-two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners did on the 17th day of February A. D. 1897, locate and by this notice do hereby create a Quartz claim known as the Lawrence lead or vein claim, said claim having been discovered this 24th day of January 1897, and do claim fifteen hundred feet or feet on this lead, lead or vein bearing mineral in places, by six hundred feet in middle, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or ledges, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) situated in Copper Creek District County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows: First: commencing at this stake and notice on Raster creek it runs 1500 feet in a northerly direction to the center end stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the south west corner stake thence 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the southwest corner stake in Raster creek thence up the stream of Raster creek 300 feet to center end stake thence up the stream of Raster creek 300 feet along the line of the Old mine claim to the south east corner stake thence 500 feet in a northerly direction to the northwest corner stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the center end stake the discovery is in Raster creek near center end stake and I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
