

History of Location of the Mammie Murray Lode by D. W. Ward & H. J. Murray ..  
To whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that H. J. Murray and D. W. Ward citizens of the United States of America over the age of twenty one years having complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the state of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 17th day of February A. D. 1897, locate and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim known as the Mammie Murray lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 24th day of January 1897 and do claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes (the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) situated in Coppe creek mining district - County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

Commencing at this stake and notice on Raster creek it runs 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the center end stake thence 800 feet in a westerly direction to the southwest corner stake thence 1000 feet in a northerly direction along the line of the Nellie Mc claim to the northeast corner stake. Thence up the stream of Raster creek 300 feet to center end stake thence 300 feet up the stream of Raster creek to the northeast corner stake thence 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the south east corner stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the center end stake.

The discovery is 100 feet above the falls in Raster creek, and we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and the state of Washington.
