

Notice of location of the Quartz claim Johnston by W. P. Johnston
Whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that W. P. Johnston a citizen of the United States of America over the age of twenty one years having complied with the requirements of Chapter six of title thirty two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 17th day of February A.D. 1897 locate and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim known as the Johnston lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 23rd day of January 1897, and do claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes, the top or spur of which lie within said boundaries situated in Rappahannock mining district County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by references to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows to wit: Commencing at this stake and notice on Raster Creek it runs 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the center end stake thence 100 feet in a westerly direction to the south west corner stake thence 1000 feet in a northerly direction along the line of the Clarence claim to the north west corner stake on Raster Creek thence up the center of Raster Creek 300 feet to the center end stake thence up the center of Raster Creek 500 feet to the north east corner stake thence 1000 feet in a southerly direction to the south east corner stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the center end stake the discovery is in Raster Creek at north center end stake and I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
