

Notice of location of the Quartz claim known as by Joseph Manning.  
Edition it may concern.

Section is hereby given that Joe. M. Manning citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty one, years, having complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty two of the revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of February A. D. 1897, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim, known as the Manning's lead or copper claim, said claim having been discovered the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January 1897, and do claim fifteen hundred linear feet on the lead lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the vein being three hundred feet on each side of the center line, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or spur of which lies within said boundaries (Twenty acres of placer mining ground), situated in Copper Creek Mining District County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at this stake and notice on Raster creek 16 rods 1500 feet in a northerly direction to the center end stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the northwest corner stake thence 1500 feet in a southerly direction along the lines of the George Manning claim to the southeast corner stake on Raster creek thence 300 feet up the stream of Raster creek to the center end stake thence 300 feet up the stream of Raster creek to the south east corner stake thence 100 feet in a northerly direction to the northeast corner stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the center end stake.

The discovery is 150 feet above the falls on Raster creek and is intended to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
