In compliance with the U. S. Mining Laws and the regulations of St Helens Mining District, Klamath County, State of Washington I located the northeast Discovery claim of the Samson Scandus lode. Locality Upper North Tonale Valley Samson Basin claim on gulch about 400 feet higher up in gulch than entrance of Samson Tunnel. Location notice on western slope of gulch at the same spot as Samson Findus claim.
