

Notice of location of this claim registered by Geo. W. Aker & J. M. Barrett.
To whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that Geo. W. Aker & J. M. Barrett citizens of the United States of America, over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six of title thirty two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the state of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 20th day of February A.D. 1897, locate and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim, known as the Myrtle lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 12th day of December 1896 and its claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dip, spur and angles and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lies within said boundaries twenty acres of placer mining ground situated in Copper Creek Mining District County of Shumaius State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

Commencing at this stake and notice on the trail half way between Canyon creek and Copper Creek, it runs 1000 feet in a northerly direction from center of Canyon Creek to the center end stake, thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the north west corner stake, thence 1500 feet in a southerly direction to the south west corner stake on Canyon Creek thence 300 feet up the stream of Canyon Creek to the center end stake thence 300 feet up the stream of Canyon Creek to the south east corner stake thence 300 feet in a northerly direction to the north end end stake thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the center end stake. The discovery is near center end stake this notice is on a large hand made tree staked & marked thus xxx. and we intend to locate and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the state of Washington.
