

Notice of location of the quartz claim Royal Charlie by Charles J. Ward
to whom it may concern

Notice is hereby given that Charles J. Ward citizen of the United States of America over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of chapter 24 of title thirty two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the state of Washington and the local customs laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 20th day February A. D. 1897, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim, known as the Royal Charlie lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 27th day of October 1896, and to claim fifteen hundred feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes or lodges, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries. Situated in Copper Creek Mining district County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

commencing at the stake and notice on Charlies Creek it runs 1000 feet in a northerly direction to center end stake thence 800 feet in an easterly direction to the North east corner stake thence 1000 feet in a southerly direction along the line of the Big Stella claim to the South east corner on Charlies Creek thence 800 feet down the stream of Charlies Creek to the center end stake thence 800 feet down the stream of Charlies Creek in a westerly direction to the South west corner stake thence 1000 feet in a northerly direction to the North west corner stake thence 800 feet in an easterly direction along the line of the Genesieve claim to the center end stake, and is intended to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of
