Notice is hereby given that a citizen of the United States over the age of twenty one years has this seventh day of July 1883 discovered a vein or lode of quartz sand rock, bearing gold, silver and lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located situated on the head waters of Canyon Creek in the County of Skamania and the Territory of Washington and known as the Eagle Lode, and has this seventh day of July 1883 under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States located fifteen linear feet of this vein or lode in length running to and from this notice at the prospect or discovery shaft, the exterior boundaries of this claim being plainly marked by reference to natural objects and permanent monuments or more particularly described as follows to wit: Beginning at a point in the centre of the lode at the prospect or discovery shaft and running north westerly fifteen hundred feet in length with surface ground of three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said vein or lode including all dips, spurs and angles with the right to sufficient water from the creek crossing said vein or lode for working the same, and that I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local laws customs and usages of miners and the mining laws of the United States.
