

Notice of location of the quartz claim Jenny Branch by Charles Mead and C. Cole to whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that Charles Mead and C. Cole citizens of the United States of America over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners did, on the first day of March A.D. 1897, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim known as the Jenny Branch lode or mining claim said claim having been discovered the first day of March 1897, and its claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) twenty acres of mining ground situated in Copper Creek Dist. County of Skamania State of Wash. said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural obj. to or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to wit:

This claim is on Copper Creek and lays on the east side of the claim known as the Maggie B. the center stake is in Copper Creek and the claim runs 100 in a southerly direction it is staked and is described as follows beginning at the center stake at north end thence 300 feet east to northeast stake at corner thence 150 feet in a southerly direction to the southeast corner stake thence 300 feet west to center stake at south end thence 150 feet west to the southwest corner stake thence 100 feet north along the claim Maggie B. to the northwest corner stake thence 150 feet east to center stake at north end.

And we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and of the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
