

notice of location of the claim Green Horn by T. C. Satterfield
To whom it may concern

notice is hereby given that T. C. Satterfield a citizen of the United States of America over, the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of chapter IX of title two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 27th day of March A. D. 1897, locate and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim known as the Green Horn lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the 27 day of March 1897, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode, or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dikes, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lies within said boundaries) (mining ground) situated in ^{Copper Creek District} the first creek north of Copper Creek County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

This claim runs 1500 feet in a southerly direction bounded as follows commencing center stake at the north end at the center of said creek then running 500 feet in a westerly direction to N. W. corner stake then 1500 feet in a southerly direction along the line of the claim known as the suppur to the south west corner stake, 500 feet in a easterly direction to S. E. stake then 500 feet in a easterly direction to S. E. corner stake then 1000 feet in a northerly direction to N. E. corner stake then 500 feet in a westerly direction to N. E. stake.

and we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Wash.
