In compliance with the U.S. Mining Law and the regulations of St. Helens Mining District Skamania County Washington State I located the Northwest Discovery claim of the Frederick Lode Locality same place Upper North Fork Valley the same as Alcation Lode Discovery but about 800 feet further and 200 feet higher in the gulch boundaries from the place of discovery marked by a post directly in the vein 30° North 20° East thence 1500 feet north 70° West thence 600 feet south 80° West thence 1500 South 70° East thence 300 feet north 20° East to place of beginning.
