Mining Laws and the regulations of St. Helens' Mining District, Klamath County, State of Washington, I located the Southwest Discovery Claim of the George Le Lode Locality German Gulch, Upper North Tuttle Valley, North Slope of Star Mountain the same as Aleatic Lode Claim but above the forks of the creek on western slope of mountain location where on a big rock of a fir tree boundaries from place of discovery in creek bed 300 feet South 70° East thence 150 feet South 20° west thence 600 feet north 70° West thence 150 feet north 20° East thence 300 feet South 70° East to place of discovery. Direction magnetic, feet linear.

Notice of Location

In compliance with the U. S. Mining Laws and the regulations of St. Helens' Mining District, Klamath County, State of Washington, I located the East Discovery Claim of the Germania Lode Locality German Gulch, the same as Aleatic Lode Discovery but about 400 feet further and 100 feet higher in the gulch. Discovery pit about 60 feet northwest from a blazed big Fir tree boundaries from the place of discovery 300 feet north thence 150 feet east thence 600 feet south thence 150 feet west thence 300 feet north to place of discovery. Direction magnetic, feet linear.
