Notice is hereby given that F. S. Clark & G. S. Garwood citizens of the United States of America over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter six of title thirty two of the revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 19th day of October A. D. 1896 locate and by this notice do, hereby locate a Lode claim known as the Elma lode or mining claim said claim having been discovered the 17th day of October 1896, and its claim fifteen hundred feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral or place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lies within said boundaries (twenty acres of said claim situated in Cedar Creek mining district County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows to wit: Beginning at discovery post running 300 feet to the Southwesterly corner post thence 1500 feet to the Southeastly cor. post thence 300 feet to easterly and center post thence 300 feet to North easterly corner post thence 1500 feet in a westerly direction to Northwesterly corner post thence 300 feet in a southerly direction to place of beginning at discovery post. This mining claim joins the Hidden Treasures on the easterly end.

And we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington
