

Notice of location of the mine Elma by Frank S. Clark and George S. Garwood.
To whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that F. S. Clark & G. S. Garwood citizens of the United States of America over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty two of the revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 19th day of October A. D. 1896 locate and by this notice do, hereby locate a Lode claim known as the Elma lode or mining claim and claim having been discovered the 1st day of October 1896, and is claims fifteen hundred feet on the lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spur and angles and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lies within said boundaries (twenty acres of said claim situated in Cedar Creek mining district County of Skamania State of Washington) said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at discovery post running 300 feet to the southeasterly cor. post thence 1500 feet to the southeasterly cor. post thence 300 feet to easterly and easterly post thence 800 feet to northeasterly corner post thence 1500 feet in a westerly direction to northwesterly corner post thence 800 feet in a northerly direction to place of beginning at discovery post. This mining claim joins the Hidden Treasure on the easterly end.

And we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining law of the United States and of the State of Washington.
