

Notice of location of the claim Pender foot by A. J. Stalmaker
To whom it may concern

Notice is hereby given that A. J. Stalmaker citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty two of the revised statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 20 day of February A. D. 1897 locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim, known as the Pender foot lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered this 20 day of February 1897 and its claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) (twenty acres of placer mining ground) situated in Canyon creek district County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on Pop. creek 1/2 mile from its junction with Canyon creek and running thence 300 ft 80° S.W. to a maple stake thence 1000 ft 80° S.E. to a fir stake thence 600 ft 86° N.E. to a maple stake thence 1000 ft 80° N.W. to a maple stake thence 300 ft 80° S.W. to point of beginning.

And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
