In compliance with the U. S. Mining laws and the regulations of St. Helens Mining District, Klamath County, State of Washington, I located the South East Discovery claim of the Samson Excelsior Lode locality about 500 feet west from the Samson Superior Lode. Discovery in a gulch torn in the pumice stone above the cliffs of Samson gulch Upper North Fork River Basin. Location Notice about 30 feet S 15° E from discovery on the roots of a big windface boundaries. From place of discovery 300 feet north 50° East thence 1500 feet South 85° East thence 600 feet South 50° West thence 1500 feet North 85° west thence 300 feet north 50° East to place of beginning. Direction magnetic, feet linear
