

notice of location of the claim Snow Flake by A. R. Putman
To whom it may concern

notice is hereby given that A. R. Putman citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty one years, having complied with the requirements of chapter six of title thirty two of the revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the twenty sixth day of February A. D. 1897, locate and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim known as the Snow Flake lode or mining claim, said claim having been discovered the twenty fifth day of February 1897, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries situated in Lewis River district county of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to wit:

Beginning at the center stake of the Fortune Mining Claim (North No. 2 and running 88° N. E. 300 ft to the N. E. corner of Fortune claim No. 2. thence 88° N. W. 1500 ft to a maple stake thence 80° S. W. 600 ft to a maple stake thence 80° S. E. 1000 ft to the N. W. corner of Fortune claim 2 then 80° N. E. 300 ft to the point of beginning.

And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
