

Notice of location of claim Kentucky No 2 by F. John Wenz.
To whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned citizen of the United States having complied with all the requirements of Chapter six (6) title thirty two (32) revised statutes of the United States and local mining laws, rules and regulations, has located a lode of Gold and silver bearing quartz, on Carolan Creek, in Skamania County Wash. and in south fork Lewis river mining district, described as follows to wit: Beginning at location notice and running 85 degrees North east along the N. end line of "Ky. No. 1" 300 feet to the W. line of "Fortune" to the southeast stake, thence running North west 85 degrees 1500 feet along the W. line of "Fortune" to stake on northeast cor. W. by fir tree 5 feet in diameter 40 feet N.E. one fir tree 8 ft diam. 90 feet W. thence running 85 deg. Southwest 650 feet to N. 1/2 Cor. stake W. by hemlock tree 16 inch diam. 12 feet N.E. one Hem. tree 20 inch diam. 21 feet S.E. thence running 85 deg. Southeast 1500 feet to the S.W. cor. stake W. by fir tree 3 feet diam. 30 feet S.W. one hemlock 18 inch diam. 4 feet N.W. thence running 85 deg. North east along N. end line of "Ky. No. 1" 300 feet to place of beginning and known as the Kentucky No. 2.
