 notice is hereby given that the undersigned a citizen of the
 United States over the age of twenty one years having complied with
 the requirements of Chapter six (6) of title thirty two (32) of the
 revised statutes of the United States, and of all other mining
 laws thereof, did, on the 12th day of April 1897 locate a quartz
 claim of 20 acres, situate in the county of Skamania State of
 Washington and more particularly described as follows
 situated on a small creek a tributary of the south fork of Lewis
 river, south east of Green Horn mine about one thousand feet
 (1000) commencing at center of said ledge and running north east
 (300) feet to a stone thence S. E. (1000) feet to stone thence S. W. (1000)
 to a stone thence N. W. (1000) feet to a stone thence N. E. (300) feet to
 place of beginning.
