

To whom it may concern, Notice is hereby given that we the undersigned citizens of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 21st day of August 1896, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a quartz claim, known as the Bryan Mine Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the 21st day of August 1896, and do claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode or vein showing mineral in place, & six hundred feet in width the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries, (hereby acres of placer mining ground) situated in Lookout Mountain County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at this stake and notice it runs 500 feet in a South by Direction from this notice and 100 feet extra to make it 600 feet and 700 feet in a North by Direction and 200 feet extra to make it 900 feet and 200 feet on each side of the center thereof situated about 5 miles from Lookout Mountain 1 mile from camp 7 in the trail situated in Lookout Mountain Mining District State of Washington
