

Notice of Location or Placement of Ida Martin by W E Satterfield
To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given,
That J. W. E. Satterfield a Citizen of the United States of
America, over the age of twenty-one years, having com-
plied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-
two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all
other mining laws thereto, and of the State of Utah and
the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of mining,
did, on the 17th day of May A.D. 1897, locate, and by this
notice do hereby locate a Lode Claim, known as the Ida
Martin Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been
discovered the 17th day of August 1896, and do claim (Eighty
hundred linear feet in this lode, or over bearing min-
eral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being
three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together
with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or
lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries)
(literally, veins of ground) situated in Copper Creek Mining
Dist. County of Mohave State of Utah, said location being
described and distinctly marked by reference to natural ob-
jects or permanent monuments, and more particularly de-
scribed as follows, to-wit:

Relocated

This claim is bounded on the North by the Big Elephant
Claim and Yellow Bird claim this claim runs 1500 feet in a
southerly direction from North Corner Stake and thence 300
feet in a westerly direction to North East corner stake
and thence 1500 feet in a southerly direction to South East
corner stake and thence 300 feet along the North line of the
Big Stella Claim in a westerly direction to South East
corner stake and thence 300 feet along the North end of Big Stella
claim running in a westerly direction to South East
corner stake and thence 1500 feet in a Northerly direction along
the East line of the claim known as the junction to North
West corner stake and thence 300 feet in a easterly direction
to North corner stake place of beginning and I intend to
load and work said claim in accordance with the
local customs and rules of Mining and the Mining Laws of
the United States and of the State of Utah.
