The United States of America to all to whom these presents shall come greeting whereas these has been desposited in the general land Office of the United States a certificate numbered one hundred and nineteen of the Register and Receiver at Vancouver Washington Territory whereby it appears that under the provisions of the act of Congress approved the 27th day of September 1850 entitled an act to create the Office of Surveyor General of the Public lands in Oregon and to provide for the Survey and to make donation to settlers of the said Public lands and the legislation supplemental thereto, the claim of Charles Frese of Skamania County Washington Territory Notification No. 579, has been established to a donation of one half section or three hundred and twenty acres of land and that the same has been surveyed and designated the Surveyor General as fractional Section eleven, in township one North of range five east in the district of lands subject to sale at Vancouver Washington Territory containing two hundred and eighty acres and fifty hundredths of an acre.

Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the provision of the act aforesaid have given and granted and by those presents do give and grant unto the said Charles Frese and to his heirs the tract of land above described to have and to hold the said tract with the appurtenances unto the said Charles Frese and to his heirs, and assigns forever in Testimony whereof I, Andrew Johnson President of the United States have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the general land office to be hereunto affixed given under my hand at the city of Washington this twenty second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty five and of the Independence of the United States the Ninetieth.
