

Notice of Location of "Lawrence M" by J.K. Manning To whom it may concern

Notice is hereby given, that J.K. Manning citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 8th day of May 1897, locate, and by this Notice do hereby locate a Lode or Mining Claim, known as the Lawrence M Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the 8th day of May 1897, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs, and angles, and all other veins (or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) (extending across of mining ground), situated in Copper Creek Mining District County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at this Notice on a large white fir tree, it runs 1000 feet in a southerly direction on the eastern of the lead lode or vein and 300 feet easterly, and 300 feet westerly from the center of the lead, lode or vein. The discovery is at Notice at the head of a canyon and we suppose the place to be Summer Spring. The Dole trail is about 250 feet South of this Notice and discovery and the stream known as Raymond Creek is about 1000 feet South of Notice and South center end State is 500 feet South of Raymond Creek. This claim will touch the East side of the Hazel claim located by H.W. Viddings on Raymond Creek. Center line is blazed through and corners established on this claim. And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
