Homestead Certificate No. 814. Application 2387. Whereas there has been deposit-  
ed in the General land office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of  
the land office at Vancouver Washington Territory whereby it appears that pursuant  
to the act of congress approved 20th May 1862 to secure Homestead to actual settlers  
on the Public domain and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of Edward Under-  
wood has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South  
East quarter of the North West quarter the south half of the North East quarter and  
the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section twenty two in Township  
three North of Range ten East of Willamette Meridian in Washington Territory con-  
taining one Hundred and sixty acres according to the official Plat of the Survey of  
the said land returned to the general land office by the Surveyor General. Now know  
ye that these is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Edward Under-  
wood the tract of land above described to have and to hold the said tract of land  
with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Edward Underwood and to his heirs and  
assigns forever subject to any vested and accused water rights for mining, agricul-  
tural, manufacturing or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in  
connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the loc-  
al customs laws and decisions of courts and also subject to the right of the propr-  
ietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be  
found to penetrate or intersect the Premises hereby granted as provided by law in  
Testimony whereof I, Chester A. Arthur President of the United States of America  
have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the general land Office  
to be hereunto affixed given under my hand at the city of Washington the tenth day  
of February in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and Eighty Two and  
of the Independance of the United States the one hundreth and sixth by the President  
Chester A. Arthur, by W.H. Cook, Secretary, S.W. Clark recorder of the General land
