

Notice of location of Shamrock by Joseph M. Manning
To sustain it may concern

Notice is hereby given, that Joseph M. Manning, Citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title 23, Sec. 1, of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other remaining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners did on the 12th day of May AD 1897, locate, and by this Notice do hereby locate a Lode Mining Claim, known as the Shamrock Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered on the 12th day of May 1897, and do claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries (Twenty acres of mining ground), situated in Copper Creek Mining District, County of Skamania, State of Washington, said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

Commencing at this large bar and Notice, I do claim 1500 feet running in a Northerly direction on the center of this lode, lode or vein and 200 feet Easterly, and 300 feet Westerly, from the center thereof as shown by the outcroppings. The discovery shaft is at the south end near the Notice, The North end of this claim joins the South end of the Lawrence M. claim. The center line and end lines are blazed out and the four corners established.

And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners, and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
