

Notice of Location of Lumber Claim "Occident" By E. E. Hough et al
 Notice is hereby given, That the undersigned Citizens
 of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, on the
 5 day of April 1897, located a vein or lode of Lumber or Land
 Rock in place, bearing Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits
 of the claim hereby located and have this 5 day of April
 1897, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes
 of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet
 of this vein or lode in length with surface ground, three
 hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said
 lode, situated in the Copper Creek Mining District, County
 of Skamania and State of Washington and known as the
 Occident Mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred
 feet to and from this Notice; the exterior boundaries of
 this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural
 objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly de-
 scribed as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the stake and
 Notice and running 300 feet in an Easterly direction along
 the center of Canyon Creek to Southeast corner stake thence
 100 feet in a Northerly direction to North East corner stake
 thence 300 feet in a Westerly direction to North center end
 stake, thence 300 feet in a Westerly direction to North West
 corner stake thence 1000 feet in a Southerly direction to
 South West corner stake thence 300 feet along the center
 of Canyon Creek to South center end Stake where this
 Notice is posted and that we intend to hold and work
 said above described claim as provided by the local
 laws and customs and rules of miners and mining stat-
 utes and laws of the United States.
