

Location Notice of "Gold Mount" by Percy Harrison

Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned Citizen of the United States, over the age of 21 years, having complied with Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and all the Local Laws, customs and regulations have located a lode claim extending 1000 linear feet along the lode or vein, to be known as the "Gold Mount" claim, situated in the Copper Creek Mining District, Skamania County, State of Washington, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at place of discovery on South fork of Lewis river, where Notice is posted on large fir tree; and running N 20 degrees W for a distance of 1500 ft to post marked N. center part of "Gold Mount" claim and extending 300 ft on the W. and 300 ft on the E. of center line: This claim is bounded on the S by the Silver Mount claim and on the W. by the Robbers claim and about a mile and half up Lewis river from the mouth of Slide creek. This claim was discovered and located on April 15th, 1897.
