To secure Homestead to actual Settlers on the public Domain and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Francisco Dillon has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the East half of the Northeast quarter of section thirty in township two North of range five east of Willamette Meridian in Washington Territory containing eighty acres, according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.
