To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned, citizen of the United States, over the age of 21 years, having complied with all the requirements of Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of the United States and all the State and Local Laws, have located a luster claim extending 10000 linear feet along this lode or vein, to be known as the "Faith" claim situated in Seaman's County, State of Massachusetts, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning on a small branch of Republican creek, where discovery was made and where Notice was posted on a large fir tree and running 10000 ft.
