and assigns forever subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as maybe recognized and acknowledged by the local laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law. In testimony whereof I, Chester A. Arthur President of the United STates of America have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand at the City of Washington the Seventh day of January in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and Eighty five and of the Independence of the United States the Onehundred and Nonth.
