

Notice of Location of "Center Star" by John Tinsch
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby
 given that the undersigned Citizen of the United States, having
 complied with all the requirements of Chapter 6 Title 52 of the
 Revised Statutes and local mining laws, rules and customs
 having located a Lode & claim on the Lode or Vein to be
 known as the "Center Star" Lode in Sumner County State of
 Washington on unsurveyed land between Quinn's River and Little River.

Beginning at the North Center part of the "Venus" claim and run-
