

Notice of Location of Kentucky No 1 by Carolyn & Wend
 To whom it may concern. Notice is hereby given
 that the undersigned Citizens of the United States having com-
 plied with all the requirements of Chapter (6) Six Title Thirty
 two (32) Revised Statute of the United States and local Mining
 laws, rules and regulations here located a Lode of Gold and
 Silver bearing Lode on Carolan Creek, in Seamonie County, Wash.
 and in South Fork Lewis River Mining District, described as fol-
 lows, to-wit:

Beginning at Location Notice near meridian 85 deg. North East
 300 feet (along South end line of Kentucky No 2 to Stake of Ch. N. E. Cor.
 and connecting with west line of "Fortune" thence running 85
 deg. South East 500 feet along "fortune" line to a cor. Stake of
 Ch. South E. cor. bit by Hemlock tree 14 inch in diam 50 feet 70
 deg. N.E. one Hemlock tree, diam 50 feet N.W. 50 deg. to N.E. Cor. of
 "Cracker No 1" mine, thence running along said N. End line 85
 deg. 500 feet South West to Ch. South West Cor. 50 feet beyond
 Ch. Cor. of "Cracker No 1", bit by Hemlock tree 12 inch, diam. 4
 feet N. E. 85 deg. one Hemlock tree, diam. 20 feet N.W. 50 deg.
 thence 85 deg. North West 500 feet to Ch. N.W. Cor. bit by 5 feet
 5 ft. diam 500 feet S.W. one Hemlock tree 4 feet N.W. thence
