

Notice of Location of "Green Mountain Bay" by McIntyre & Wenz
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that
 the undersigned Citizens of the United States, having complied
 with all the requirements of Chapter Six (6) Title Thirty-two (32)
 Revised Statutes of the United States, and local mining laws, rules
 and regulations, has located a Lode of Gold and Silver bearing quartz
 on "Coralan Creek" in Kamonia County, Ariz., and Salt Fork Linn
 River Mining district; and described as follows, to-wit:
