

Notice of Location of "Three Friends" by Putzinger, Volker, Orill & Wend

To whom it may concern, Notice is hereby given that the undersigned Citizens of the United State having complied with Chapter Six (6) Title Thirty-two (32) Revised Statute of the United States, and local mining laws, rules and regulations, have located a Lode of Gold and Silver bearing quartz on "Green Mountain" Shamana Pueblo, Wash, and in South Fork Lewis River Mining District, and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at Notice of Location and running North East 85 Degrees 00 feet along the Right End line of the "Green Mountain Buy" to the North East Corner Stake, wit. by the tree 5 feet in Diam; 43 feet E, one Corner post 12 inch, Diam 6 feet S.E. thence running 85 Deg. South East 1500 feet to South East cor. Stake, wit. by the tree N.E. 18 feet this tree S, 39 feet. thence running 85 Deg. South West 600 feet to Cor. Stake wit. by the tree N.W. 22 feet, one tree S.E. 11 feet, thence running 85 North West 1500 feet to the North West Cor. Stake wit. by Hamlock tree 1 ft Diam 6 feet N.W. one Hamlock 12 inch, Diam 38 feet N.E. and the S.W. cor. of "Green Mountain Buy" thence running 85 Deg. North East 600 feet along S. end line of "Green Mountain Buy" to place of beginning, and known as the "Three Friends" Claim. Dated April 1st - 1897
