

Notice of Location of "Sphinx" Claim by Timothy Oriskany
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that
 the undersigned Citizen of the United States having complied
 with all the requirements of Chapter 6 Title 52. Revised Statute
 of the United States, and local mining laws, rules and regulations
 has located a lode of Gold and Silver bearing quartz on a small
 stream running from West to East and emptying into McKinley
